

Dear Parents and Carers,

Today, I am today issuing the new staffing list for 2020-2021 overleaf which lets you know which class teacher will be taking your child's class.

We will not be mixing any classes this year. It is only with Reception that this is slightly different as they enter classes for the first month of school and are then set in their classes, Blue or Green, once we have a better understanding of the cohort as over half of the children will be new to the school in September.

There are some changes in the staff team as sadly Lily and Zara will leave us as class teachers to move to Stroud Green Primary School and also Coelina, will leave us as Inclusion Leader also to move to Stroud Green. These colleagues bring an incredibly strong skillset to the school and I am sure you will, like us all, welcome them to Ashmount. Ellie will continue to support the school in her role as Deputy Headteacher and Ross will re-join us later in the autumn term in his Deputy Headteacher role after he returns from his paternity leave.

As you are no doubt aware the government will today announce plans for schools to return in September and I will not prejudge that here. However, in preparation for that return we would like to invite all children (except for our current Year 6s who will enjoy a fantastic send off the day before!) to join us on Friday July 17th. This will be on a pod basis, of 15 children in the morning and 15 children in the afternoon, to meet their new class teacher. The first group in each class would be with us from 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. and the second group from 1:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m. Unfortunately, lunch will not be available on this day. Arrangements for Reception and Nursery will be announced shortly. We will contact all families to let you know which group your child will be in and how the logistics for this will work early next week. We hope that this will be part of a positive end of the term and the beginning of a return to a new normal.
