



Time: 8am - 8.45am


Come to Breakfast and enjoy cereal, toast, seasonal fruits, unsweetened fruit juice, milk etc.and join in the many activities that are available:



The project is to install a soakaway to prevent the pathway from flooding during the winter months and also reinstate the hoggin pathway. They will also be installing a new fence behind the recycling bins on crouch hill. During the fencing works there will be a traffic management plan implemented.
