

Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, a reminder that on Thursday all children will spend the day with their new class teachers for the autumn term—we term this our 'Moving Up' day. Children will return to their usual form class at the end of the day so dismissal will be from their usual exits with their current year group staff.

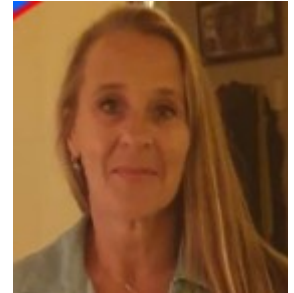

Children's Occupational Therapy Drop in

What is it?

A 20 minute virtual appointment (telephone or video).

This is a one-off appointment for advice. There is no limit to how often you would like to attend.

An opportunity to speak to an occupational therapist (OT) for advice regarding the child's/young person's development, sensory needs, and self-help skills.

Support to help you work with the child/young person to achieve their functional goals (e.g., dressing skills, scissor skills, handwriting, cutlery skills etc.)

When is it?

These are virtual appointments that run once a week on Wednesdays. There are 3 slots each week.

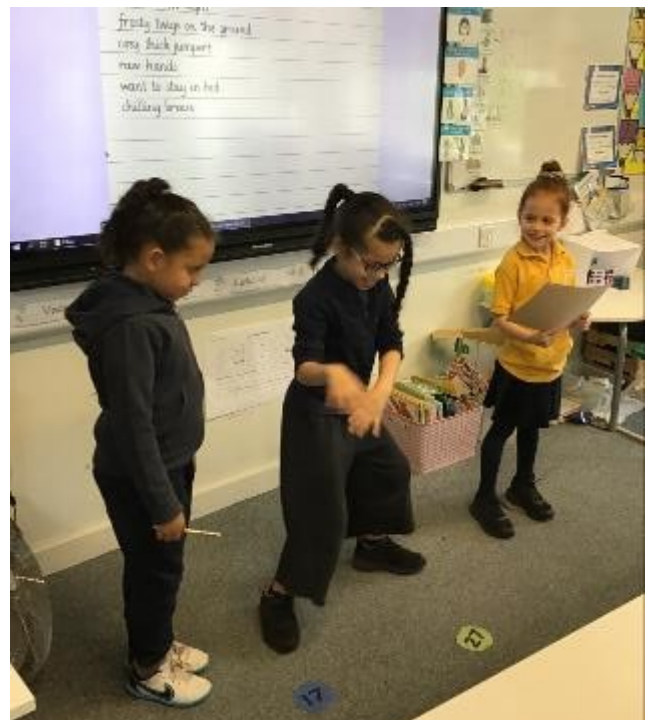
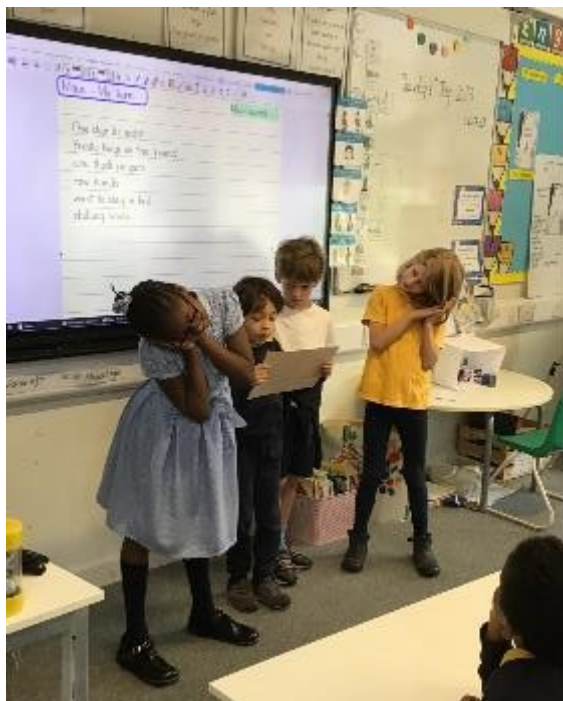
