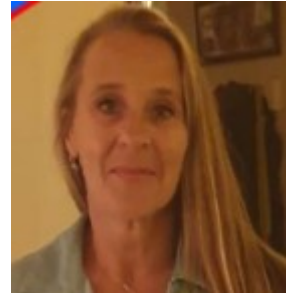

What we are learning next week:

Nursery

English- We will be continuing to explore the story 'Stanley's Stick'.

Maths- We will be making comparisons between objects relating to weight.

Reception

English: We will be continuing to explore 'We're Going On A Bear Hunt'.

Maths: We will be consolidating our maths skills we have learnt in Reception.

Year 1

English: We will be reading the story 'The Secret Sky Garden' by Linda Sarah. We will make predictions and write descriptions about how a character is feeling.

Maths: We will be consolidating our learning of number. We will be practicing partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers.

Year 2

English: We will be writing our own alternative endings to our key text 'The Fox and the star'.

Maths: We will be consolidating our learning on 2D shapes and begin exploring 3D shapes.

Year 3

English: We will continue reading 'The BFG'. We will then write an instructional text.

Maths: We will be measuring the perimeter of different 2D shapes.

Year 4:

English: We will continue to read 'The Wild Robot' and use this to create our own diary entry.

Maths: We will be consolidating our knowledge of coordinates and roman numerals.

Year 5

English: We will be exploring a short film called 'Dangle'. We will then create our own characters and write a narrative.

Maths: We will be revision the four operations and solving word problems.

Year 6

English: We will be writing a school report based on our reading of 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom'.

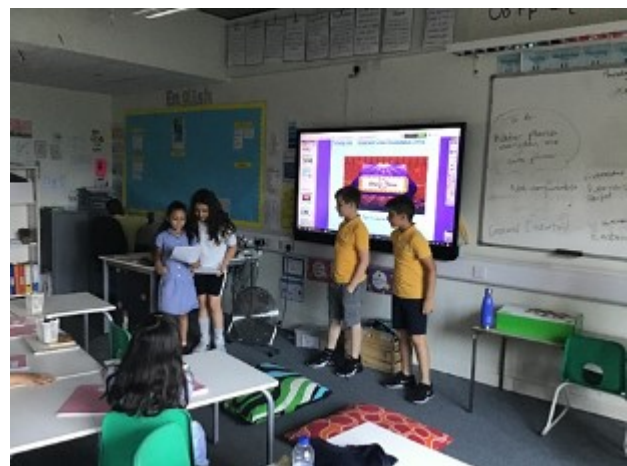

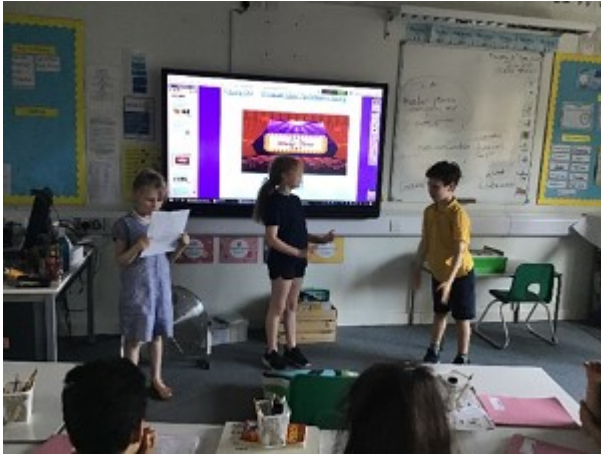

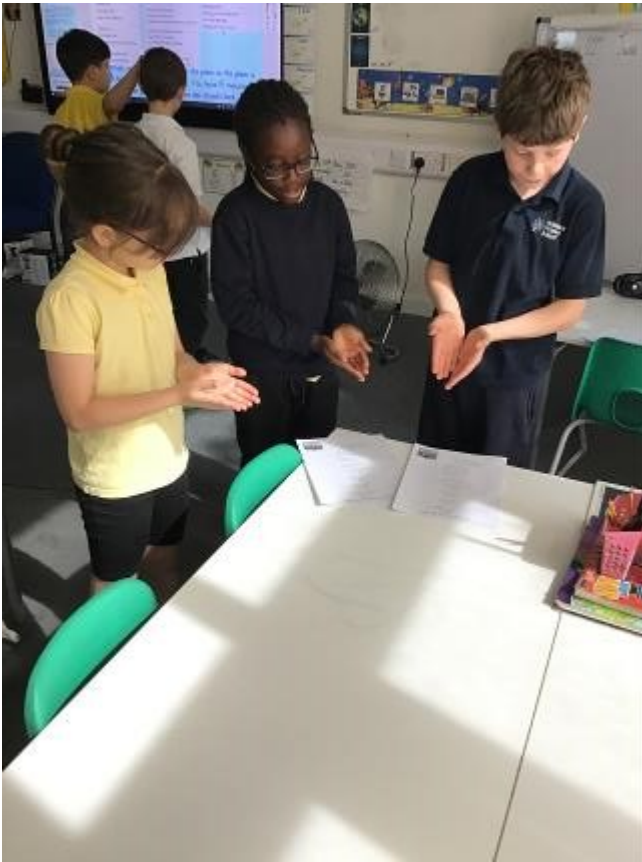

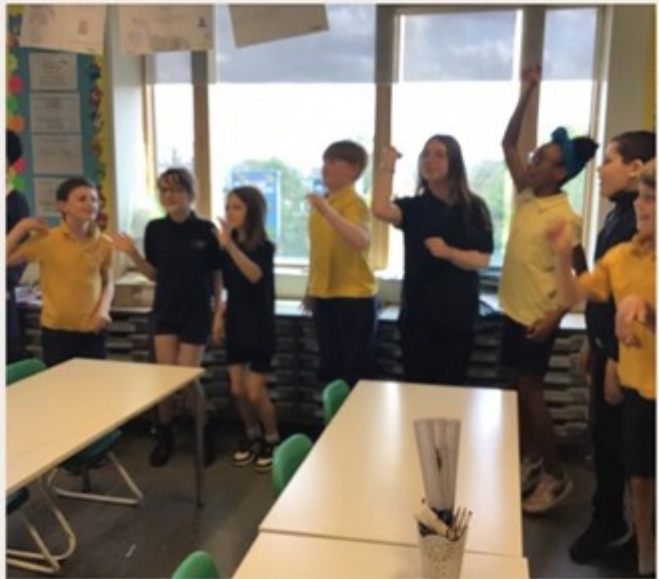
