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What we are learning next week:

Nursery

English: We will be continuing to explore stories about starting Nursery

Maths: We will be continuing to sing number songs and rhymes for 1-5.

Reception

English: We will be reading Owl Babies. We will also start learning a daily speed sound.

Maths: We will be subitising and counting numbers to 3.

Year I

English: We will be reading the story Blue Penguin and learning to retell the story using actions.

Maths: We will be ordering numbers to 10 and comparing objects using the terms 'I more than' and 'I less than'

Year 2

English: We will reading 'The Girls' by Lauren Ace. We will be writing our own version of the story.
