Finally, as with the end of each term we will finish at 2 p.m. So please make arrangements to ensure your child is picked up promptly.

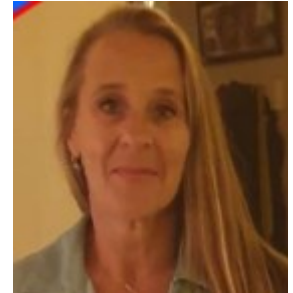

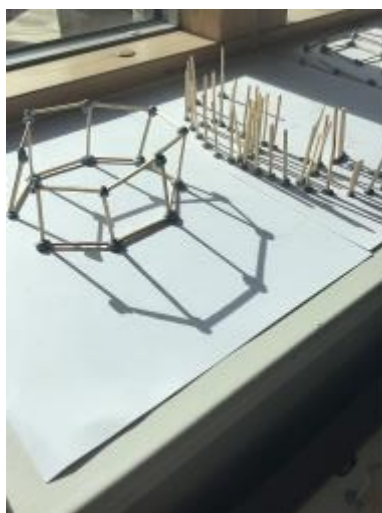
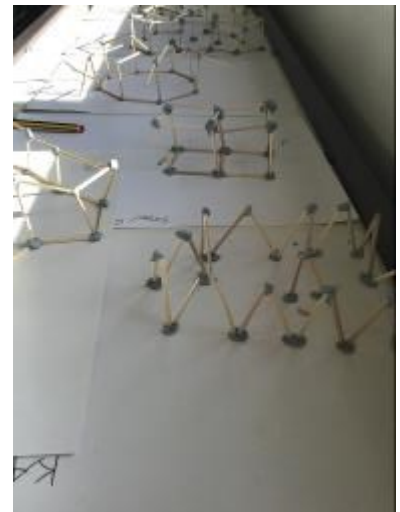
